Examples of papers could include topics such as:

- Exploring the ethical dilemmas within coaching and mentoring and/or the role of supervision in ethical practice
- Considering coaching and mentoring as a systemic enabler towards more ethical and responsible business.
- Considering the individual sustainable development goals and exploring coaching and mentoring with a focus towards a particular goals such as gender equality or health and well being

In addition, reflecting the conference theme to ask questions relating to HRDs role in shaping our global society, we invite researchers to reflect on the historical developments of the coaching and mentoring field and to take a critical look at where we are now, and what is needed to take a progressive, inclusive and ethical step forwards.
